Driveway Safety

We are now in the season of inclement weather, here is a friendly reminder of the driveway rules. Driveway service times are 8:50-9:10, 12:50-1:10, and 3:20-3:40. For safety reasons, please have your child's car seat on the passenger side of the vehicle. If this is not possible, your child needs to be able to unbuckle their car seat without assistance and exit from the passenger side of the vehicle. We need to have the children entering and exiting on that side of your vehicle, so that they aren't walking between the cars. Also it is important for you to remain in your car. This helps to keep the driveway flowing and eliminate a back up on the very busy street. Please pull up as far as you can to allow other cars to enter the circular driveway. If you need to get out of your vehicle for any reason, please use the parking lot instead. We kindly ask that you observe these rules for the safety of all at Montessori.

The children will be doing a lot of counting this month, focusing on counting thru the teen numbers. The children will also be building tens with the Positive Snake Game (adding up a large quantity and simplifying it by counting by tens).

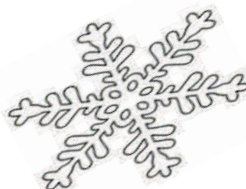
In language, we continue to review and reinforce the sounds (letters) that have been introduced, along with the introduction of c, u, p, and j. We continue to practice the isolation of sounds, which leads to word building. Some children are building words phonetically therefore, they may be spelled incorrectly (i.e. ladybug may be spelled lad~~e~~bug). Please keep in mind that your child may not be able to read these words back to you. The focus of word building is isolating each sound they hear in the word, and finding the letter that makes that sound in the moveable alphabet box.
